Sylvia Tait: A Classical Spirit

Abstract painter Sylvia Tait studied at the Montreal Museum of Fine Arts under Arthur Lismer, Jacques de Tonnancoeur and Eldon Grier before settling on the West Coast. Her work is influenced by abstract expressionism with colour infused forms clustered or linked together and migrating across the surfaces of her canvases.

This exhibition features a broad survey of Tait's work from the early 1960s to the present.

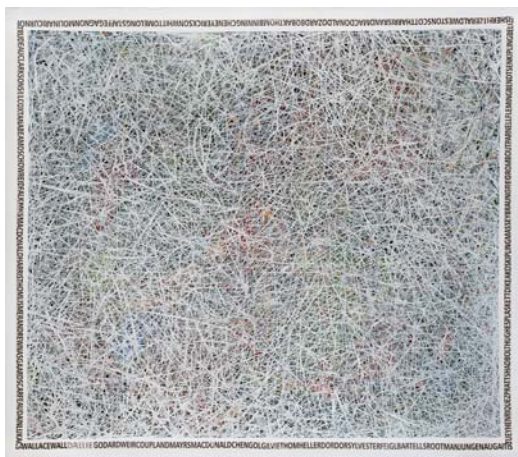


Sylvia Tait, *Moon Mine*, Oil on canvas, 1965
